

WEBCAM SETTINGS:

[1]

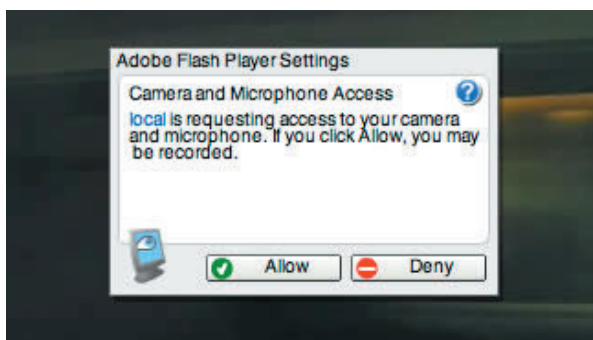
ensure your web-cam is connected to your computer and you have the flash-plugin installed.

[2]

go to <http://www.wmirtl.com/z21/>

[3]

You will find the settings panel of the flash-player:



click *Allow* to let your camera interact with the flash-movie.

IMPORTANT: no private data or images will be transmitted over the internet, the content of you web-cam recording is only visible on your own computer!

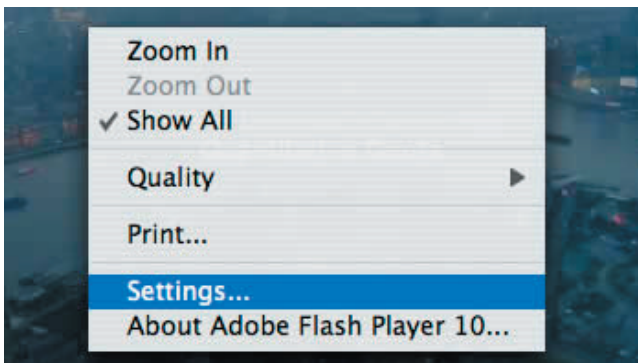
now, maybe after a few seconds, your image should appear in the above-left corner of the video.

Try some movement and watch the changing of the Text.

IF YOU CANNOT SEE YOUR IMAGE in the above-left corner of the video, you have to do some more settings:

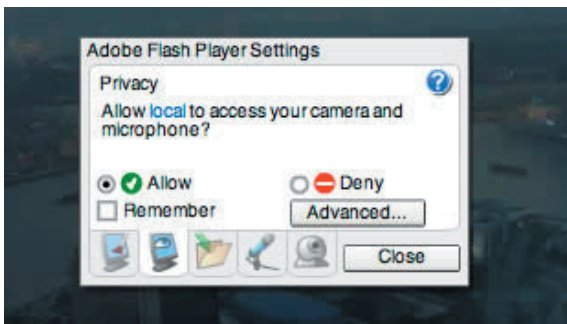

a right-click or ctrl-click with your mouse over the video will show a context menu. go to *Settings...*

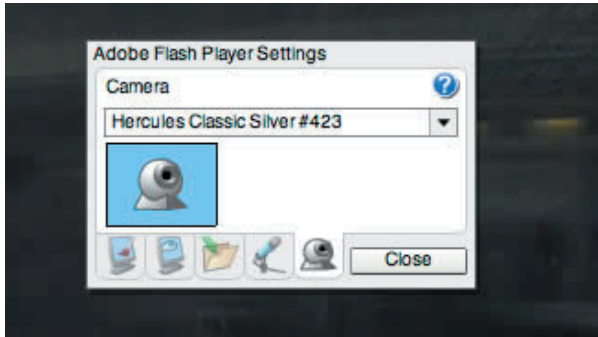
Next you should see:



click on the first image left to the close button:

Now you should see the following window:



below the word *camera* there is a pulldown menu to let you select the right video source, or video camera connected to your computer.

My camera is a *Hercules Classic Silver*

I don't think that you have the same one, so the menu shows some different cameras. If you have more than one possibilities, you have to try which camera works with the flash-plugin.

A built-in web-cam often works as *USB video class video*.

Now click *close* and reload the web-page to restart the flash-plugin

You will be asked again to *allow* the interaction of your camera and the flash-movie. I described this in step [3].
